here's what you'll need:

- * 6 sheets of tissue paper in different colors (approximately 12" x 12") for each flower
- * two 12 inch pipe cleaners (use 3 for extra strength) for each flower
- * scissors
- * ruler
- * double-sided tape
- * vase or carafe to display your flower arrangement
- * printer paper for your color printer

Mother's Day tissue paper flowers

Step 1:

for each flower, stack 6 different-colored sheets of tissue paper, measure and cut each piece to 12" x 12", then fold the stack accordian style.

Step 2

twist a pipe cleaner around the center. twist a second pipe cleaner to make a stem for your flower. you can add a third to strengthen the stem.

Step 3:

trim both ends of your folded paper to round the edges.

Step 4

open the flower by gently pulling 1 layer of tissue paper at a time toward the center.

Step 5

take at least 3 flowers (or more depending on the size of your vase) and twist the stems together to make a bouquet to place in your vase.

Step 6

print out and cut out the decorations and card. add the ribbon with double-sided tape and write a nice note to Mom in the card!


